Call the legal intake line at 414-225-1578

To get legal services, you will need to provide:

- Proof of HIV status
- Proof of residency
- Proof of income or zero income

## Other Eligibility

- For all legal services, must be **HIV positive & above 18 years old.**
- No income limit for brief legal advice.
- Must be below **500%** of the Federal Poverty Level for **Confidentiality/privacy** representation, **Discrimination** representation, and assistance with **Estate Planning & Advance Directives.**
- Must be below **125%** of the Federal Poverty Level for **Housing** representation & **Social Security** representation.
